you must apply every year after January 1st

preferable after filing taxes

FAFSA.ed.org (only use this website)

you do not have to pay for either application

State: FFAA

Includes Bright Futures and other scholarships
It is only good for Universities in the State of Florida

In order to qualify you will need to fill out the FAFSA as well.

Application becomes available starting December 1st.
